Online Learning Communities

This spring, the Canon team is pleased to invite you into a series of Online Learning Communities designed to support the shared work of ministry across the Diocese of New York. We know that this is a time of both challenge and possibility for our congregations. *Elevating local communities* is the first of our Mission Priorities. *Equipping lay & clergy leaders* is also a Mission Priority. Leadership is complex. Contexts are shifting. And yet, again and again, we see that when leaders gather—across congregations, roles, and regions—new clarity, creativity, and courage begin to emerge. These Learning Communities are offered in that spirit. Each gathering is designed as a space for practical tools, shared wisdom, and mutual support. Some are ongoing cohorts that will meet over several weeks; others are single-session workshops focused on a particular area of congregational life. Together, they reflect the breadth of ministry we share: governance, stewardship, property, formation, collaboration, and intercultural engagement. This spring's offerings include:

- Support for wardens and treasurers serving congregations in transition
- Monthly treasurer check-ins
- A property-focused community
- A series on models of collaboration in ministry
- Confirmation preparation cohorts (adult, youth, and Spanish-language)
- College for Congregational Development (CCD) continued learning
- A cultural and multilingual ministry initiative
- Vestry conversations engaging the Moses Report
- A stewardship workshop for congregational leaders

These communities are open to clergy and lay leaders as appropriate to each topic, and we encourage you to share this invitation widely within your congregation.

We offer these not as programs to complete, but as spaces to join—places where we can think together, learn from one another, and strengthen the ministries entrusted to us.

2025 Cathedral Confirmations

Diocesan confirmations will be held at the Cathedral on June 7.

Our faith is dynamic. Confirmation, reception, and reaffirmation provide an opportunity to affirm the continuing movement of the Holy Spirit in our lives.

The 1979 Book of Common Prayer describes the rituals of each rite:

- Confirmation is the affirmation of the vows made at our baptism.
- Reception welcomes people who have been confirmed in other Christian traditions into The Episcopal Church.
- Reaffirmation is for those already in The Episcopal Church who want to renew their faith commitments at a key moment in their life.

Bishops have the chance each week to participate in these rites in congregational visitations. Those are always joyous days! It's a privilege to take part. I love hearing people's formation stories. Families are really proud. (Often, there's cake.)

Canon Tanya Wallace and the Rev. Tami Burks-Condon— along with Deacon Dave Barr and Deacon Wendy Canas— are providing resources for confirmation this spring.

The rites are also meaningful when we share them together as a Diocese. Arlene Bullard is organizing the June 7 confirmation service at the Cathedral. Congregations can register for June Cathedral confirmations [here](#).

I hope that you'll join. (There will be cake.)

Canon Wallace has described a *culture of discernment* for the Diocese where we're always listening for where we're called by the promises of our baptism. This discernment is daily— and always within the community.

In the confirmation service, the question for the community is, "Will you support these persons in their life in Christ?"

Always, our answer is: "We will!"
