The community at Christ Church Marlboro

Christ Church in Marlboro received two new members.

Rennai and Rhiannon both found home at this beautiful parish in rural Ulster County on the west side of the Hudson River. Baptisms, confirmations, and receptions are always a sign of renewal for our communities.

Christ Church is preparing for the fall. Sunday school begins in two weeks. They have placed a blessing box with food out in front of the church that's now offering more than a hundred items a week for neighbors who are hungry.

- It was a joy for me to be with the community yesterday. I served as Sunday supply – and they always give their supply clergy a box of fruit and vegetables from area farms. There are five farming families in the congregation. It's a wonderful gift.

As we begin the fall, I wanted to share again how we're re-weaving our pastoral fabric around local communities like Christ Church, Marlborough and our other 172 congregations across the Diocese. We share the Gospel of Jesus Christ through our local communities, clergy, and lay leaders. We set Mission Priorities that keep us local. We organize renewal with each congregation in its actual situation. And each year, we put our people, our money, and our attention behind next steps towards renewal.

- This summer, [Religion News Service published an op-ed](#) that I wrote describing what we've learned together over the last several years.

This year's budget includes next steps for clergy support, property support, and fundraising support for local communities.

Earlier this summer, diocesan Council [adopted 2027 budget priorities](#) that recommend next steps for next year.

- The Budget Committee will complete drafting of the 2027 budget for review by Council in September.

- This fall, we'll discuss how we're carrying 2026 priorities forward and planning for 2027 as we prepare for diocesan convention in November.

Everything is meant to support congregations like Christ Church Marlboro— along with our chaplaincies and schools— in urban, suburban, and rural neighborhoods across ten countries. The ministries are grace-filled and a remarkable blessing.
